

THE GRIMALDI COLLECTION

The Grimaldi Collection is a collection of rare single cask Scotch malt whiskies, hand-selected by HSH Prince Albert II of Monaco. Each bottle drawn from the cask will be numbered and signed.

There will be a collection of 10 rare single cask whiskies, over a period of 5 years. These will be distilled and bottled at the source distillery, in partnership with and under the branding of the distillery (e.g. Glenmorangie, Dalmore, Balvenie, Glenrothes etc.).

The first bottling to be presented is a rare single cask whisky chosen by His Serene Highness at the Glenmorangie distillery.

The cask was hand-chosen by HSH Prince Albert II of Monaco at the Glenmorangie distillery in June 2015.

The whisky inside these bottles is exceptionally rare - taken from a twelve year old single unique ex-Bourbon cask.

It is of cask strength ABV 56.5% and there are only 180 bottles in the world.

No-one anywhere else in the world will be able to have this whisky, it can never be created again and no cask will ever produce the exact same liquid profile again.

TASTING NOTES

- COLOUR** Bright, sparkling pale gold.
- NOSE** Bursting with a fresh, floral and citrus bouquet, underscored by sweet creamy vanilla and white chocolate. Some distinct notes of heather and honey appear, with the perfumed notes continuing to build up.
- A little water brings forth a candy sweetness, ripe fruits like mango and peach, hints of popcorn/puff candy, and Glenmorangie's classic minty, herbal top-note.
- TASTE** A peppery mouthfeel is followed by a veritable cornucopia of sweet, fruity flavours-buttery vanilla, sweet, luscious peaches, ripe bananas, tangy limes and cooling menthol.
- FINISH** The aftertaste is gentle and soothing, with more vanilla, coconut ice cream, almond marzipan and ginger.
